Our Grade 10 Wynberg Men are just five months away from embarking on their Grade 10 Nyamezela Hike, in November. As the new Grade 10 Head, I am excited to lead this event. - 3. Payments: WBHS will subsidise R1200 of the total cost of R6900. A non-refundable deposit of R800 is required by the end of February. R5700 can be paid in full, or over 8 months (February to September).

Introducing the Wynberg Eisteddfod, August 2024

We are proud to announce the launch of the first Wynberg Boys' High School Eisteddfod for music and drama in August this year. Music entries are open for students at WBHS only, while drama entries are welcome from WBHS and Wynberg Girls' High School students.

The music section will include entries for solo performances, while bands and ensembles may still enter external eisteddfodau.

Music

We encourage every boy studying music at Wynberg, whether Subject or Non-Subject, to sign up for at least 1 item. 2 or more categories may be entered, and multiple entries of different pieces will be allowed in the same category. Performances will be held during the afternoons of the week of 19 August 2024.

- Solo entries will be R60, payable via Karri app/SnapScan.
- Audience entry will be R10, payable via SnapScan.
- All entries must be submitted by 1 August 2024, with proof of payment and name and class recorded.
- Late entries until 5 August will be accepted at the higher fee of R70.

Groups

Juniors, Grades 8 & 9 Seniors, Grades 10 - 12

All groups will have instrument categories: PIANO, PERCUSSION, WOODWIND, GUITAR, BRASS, STRINGS, and VOCAL.

The classes will be divided into BAROQUE/CLASSICAL and ROMANTIC/MODERN with the addition of a CONTEMPORARY category in the VOCAL section.
